To all the groups and organizations using Good Shepherd's facilities,

I hope this letter finds you safe and healthy. I am writing this letter to take a moment to update you on how we are moving forward through this pandemic. Originally, on the advice of our Bishop and the Governor DeWine, we had decided in mid-March to close our building and discontinue having physical worship and gatherings with the plan to re-open on June 1, 2020. As of now not many things have changed with the seriousness of this pandemic and so we are extending the closure of the building tentatively until July 1, 2020. This means the building is closed to all gatherings in the building until then.

I know many of you have keys to the building and could still enter but we ask that you refrain from doing that so that we can use this time to thoroughly clean the entire building before everyone returns to the building.

Even when we return, things will be a little different. A few things that will need to be in place for your groups and organizations when you return, according to advice from our insurance company, are:

- All people attending meetings and events will need to wear a mask.
- Hosts will have to have hand sanitizer for groups members to use during the meetings and events.
- Cleaning supplies to clean up your area after your meeting is over.

We will be following up this letter with some specifics about cleaning solutions and sanitizers as we get closer to re-opening to give you some ideas.

Another thing we will need is for people to only use the assigned rooms they have agreed to. This will help us make sure that the areas being used are definitely being kept clean and sanitized appropriately as the building is being used.

We love having the space to allow you to have a gathering place and we just want to keep it as safe as possible for all involved and we appreciate your help in this. I know all of this still seems a little disconcerting and weird, but we will get through this together.

Thank you for all that you do to make our community a better place.  
Until we can use the building again; take care of yourselves and each other.
