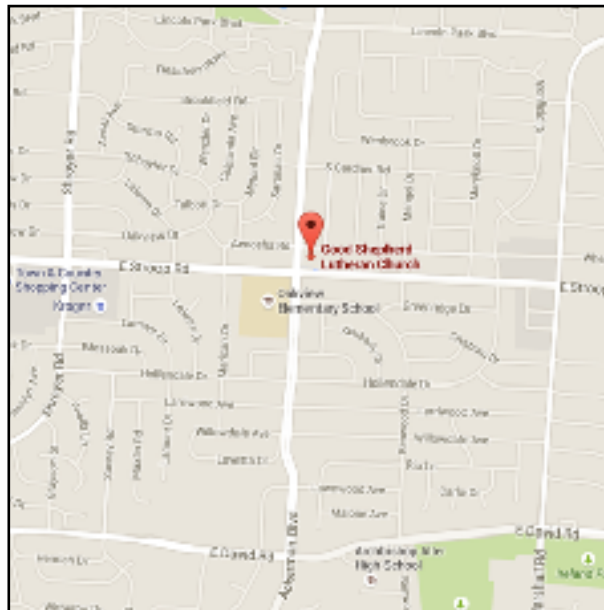

## What is Renew Day Camp?

**ReNew Day Camp** is a unique blend of congregational evangelism, outreach, and ministry to our local youth.

### ReNew Day Camp:

- Is designed for children who are pre-K through entering grade 6.
- Creates lasting memories that help lock Bible truths in a person's heart and mind.
- Provides an opportunity for youth to experience the Gospel.
- Values relationships. We strive to keep a high staff to youth ratio.
- Provides a way to build relationships with others and to Jesus Christ.
- Provides a variety of ways for the youth to experience the Gospel message.

## Schedule

9:30	Gathering	An opening to each day for celebration and praise
10:00	Self Activity	Kids engage through a “self” lens, discovering what each person can do to grow in faith and care for creation.
10:30	Community Activity	Kids engage through a “community” lens, encountering the part of creation we call community and recognizing God at work in our relationships with one another.
11:00	Games	
11:30	World Activity	Kids engage through a “world” lens, learning about all creation—from the people and parts we see every day, once in a while, and never.
12:00	Lunch	Campers eat in small groups with their counselor
12:30	Pick-up Youth	

In addition to the daily schedule, on one evening we will host dinner for campers and their families at 6:00pm with a special program following at 7:00. There is no charge for the dinner although donations will be accepted.



## Lunches and Snacks
